next week. Please pray for her as she begins her schedule of training.

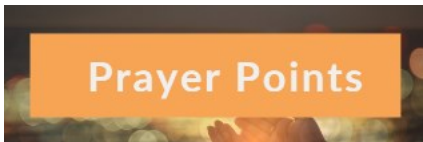
Operations Manager - Extended Deadline
