


#### **Jamaica Disaster Relief**

We are deeply saddened by the impact of the recent damage caused by Hurricane Melissa and in particular for our Jamaican members who have family and friends there. By way of a response we are encouraging those that want to help, to bring in some specific items that will be passed on to Jamaica National for aid and support.

You can drop items to A & J Hair and Beauty Salon on Cricklewood High Road or bring them to church and we will pass them on.

We are specifically collecting: Non-perishable food items (lots of tinned food, rice, instant noodles, sugar), solar lights, battery powered lights, hygiene products especially adult nappies.



#### **Reverse Pilgrimage**

On the way he observed communities and individuals that are working with displaced people and demonstrating ways that we can learn to better welcome those on similar journeys.
