Reverse Pilgrimage

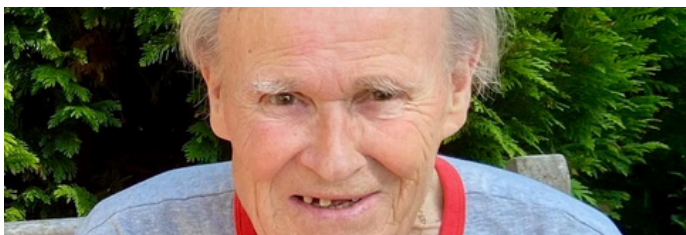
