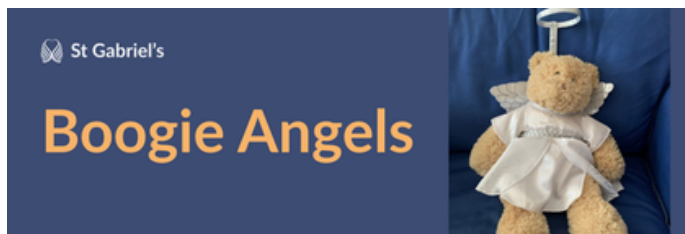
Thanks to all those that supported the event last Thursday we are please to say we have raised over £900 towards the work of CAP and Hope Café.
