English Class: throughout August, back on 7 September

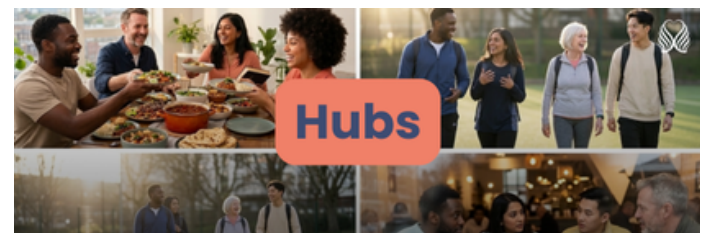
Farsi Christian Group: throughout August, back on 1 September
