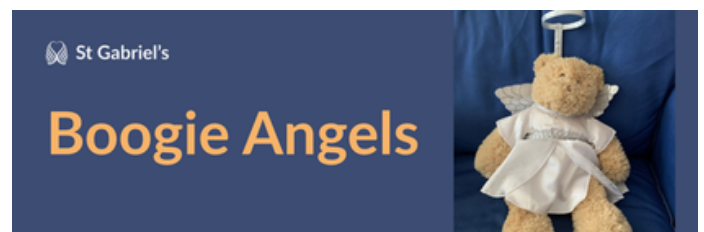
Generosity Questionnaire

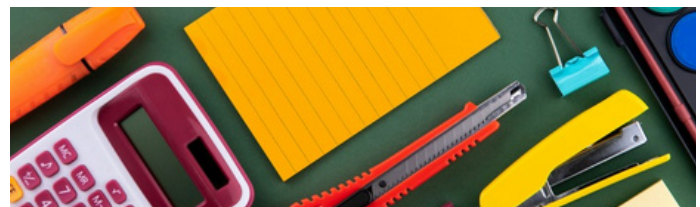
