Prayer Points

Join us as we pray:

- Pray for our city and local area. Pray for God's peace and protection on our streets, and for an end to violence, drug and knife crime. (Brent Council recently wrote to faith groups asking us to pray!)
- Ask God to strengthen and encourage the persecuted church. Pray for Christians in Iran and other countries who face severe hardship, and for those in our church who have family or friends there
- Ask God to move in power, here in Cricklewood and beyond! Pray for the signs of God's kingdom: for people to be healed, set free, for justice, forgiveness and reconciliation
- Thank God for all the children's, youth and family activities (including Boogie Angels), and pray for each of the children and young people in these groups
- Pray for the CAP team attending student events at two local colleges this week, for many good conversations and to be able to share important budgeting skills
- Pray for those looking for work, including a number of our CAP clients, to find good jobs where they will be able to thrive
- Pray for God's healing for those who are unwell
- Pray for places where there are long-term conflicts, such as Ukraine and Russia, for God to restore hope and peace. Pray for comfort for those who have lost loved ones, or whose homes or communities have been damaged; and for aid to reach those in need.
